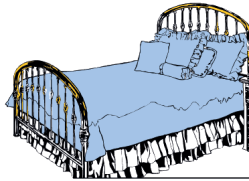

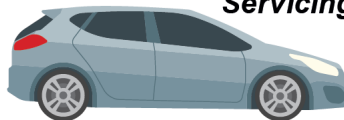

## **Crowle Parish Council – Budget Information 2026/27**

The Parish Council has responsibility for maintaining a number of areas within the Parish, such as the playing fields, play equipment, allotments, the parish garden (plus nearby land) and also has an interest in maintaining Green Pool on Netherwood Lane for the benefit of the community, although this is not owned by us.

The Parish Council is principally funded through Council Tax and other grants from local government. We also support the organisation of the 10k race and receive any surplus from that together with contributions from the various clubs and bodies that make use of the Playing Fields. We set a budget in January each year for the next financial year, which runs from 1 April until 31 March. The Finance & Risk Group of the Parish Council prepares a budget which is then put to the full Parish Council for discussion and formal approval.

In the council year 2026/27, the Council plans to finalise the Neighbourhood Plan for Crowle and complete phase 1 of the proposed Recreation Facilities project (currently under review). This includes resurfacing the track around the Jubilee Field, planting to support wilding of part of the Back Field, creating a tug-of-war practice area and improving the grass for use by the School, the Scout Group and the Football Club.

We will continue to support community groups and events, provide the Parish Lengthsman, produce our monthly parish newsletter (The Cryer) and keep the playing fields and other facilities in good order. We will continue to allocate funds to maintain/upgrade items such as the re-surfacing of the MUGA, which includes the tennis courts, and replace play equipment in future. There will also be a grant “pot” to allow local community groups to apply for funding for events or projects.
