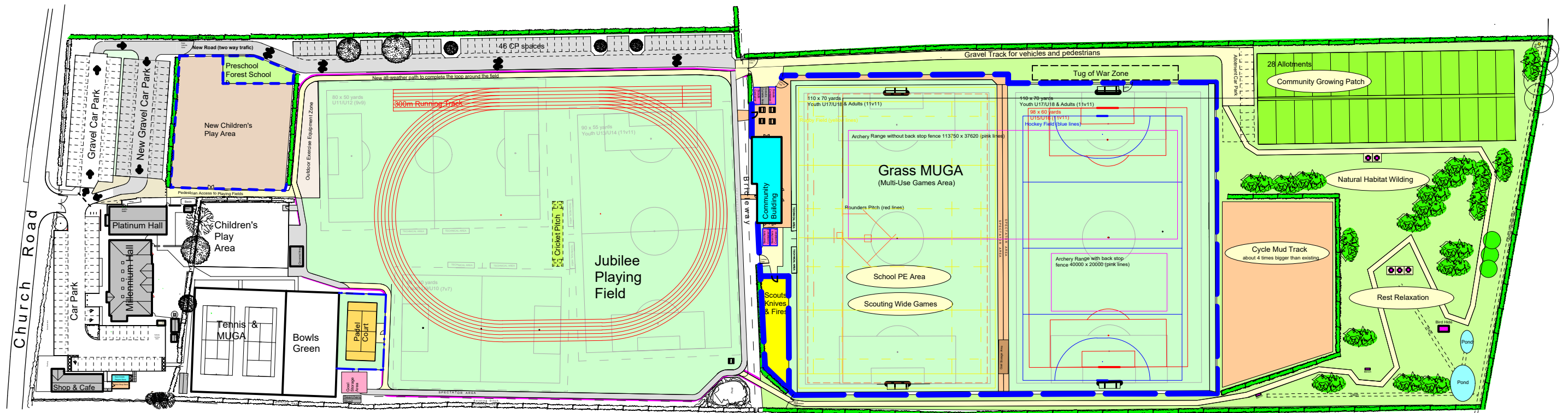


- 1) Vehicles
 - One-way system to Gravel Car Parks to aid flow
 - Removes vehicles from the track to the North side of Platinum Hall
 - Vehicles separated by a fence to Jubilee Field
- 2) Car Parking
 - Critical time Saturday during the football season.
 - Currently Searchers use Gravel Car Park and up to 30 spaces on Jubilee Field Total 66
 - This layout has 50 additional parking spaces which will cover the two extra football pitches
 - Only Allotment Parking on the Back Field
- 3) Shop & Players Container Storage
 - Planned installation spring 2026
- 4) New Children's Play Area
 - Being 'new' it will be possible to obtain grants.
 - Over double the size of the existing Children's Play Area.
- 5) Preschool Forest School
 - Relocated nearer to Millennium to reduce travel time & effort for the children
 - Short route to Public Toilet

- 6) Padel Court
 - Fast growing with few facilities in the area
 - Good hire rates so more than self-funding
- 7) Exercise Track and Running
 - Loop around Jubilee Field completed now avoids the need to use this vehicle route.
 - Loop lengths
 - Jubilee Field and the Back Field = 1.1km
 - Figure of '8' using Bridleway = 1.3km
 - Running Track located on Jubilee Field standard 300m length with 6 lanes.
- 8) Jubilee Field
 - Contains the three smallest football pitches for younger children.
 - Space for a cricket wicket in the future.
- 9) Grass MUGA
 - Fenced area to control access for child safety and provide a space to hire.
 - Space for Football, Hockey, Rugby, Rounders and Archery to recommended standards.
 - Located on the flattest part of the site to minimise ground works
 - Overhead power lines need to be removed.

- 10) Community Building
 - Located inside the fence of the Grass MUGA this provides a good combination of spaces to hire and easy access to toilets etc.
 - Not located on the Back Field
 - Public Toilet about 250m from Rest Relaxation Area
- 11) Searchers Storage Containers
 - Two containers for football equipment and possibly mowing equipment
- 12) Scouts Containers and Covered Area
 - For storage of camping and activity equipment.
 - Covered Area for drying tents etc.
- 13) Scouts Knives & Fires
 - Located within the Grass MUGA fenced area for good child protection
 - Near the Community Building for access to toilets and resources.
- 14) Tug of War
 - Located where the creation of an uneven surface is acceptable

- 15) Cycle Mud Track
 - Located on the sloping area of the site which benefits its design.
 - About 4 times bigger than the existing track
- 16) Natural Habitat Wilding & Rest Relaxation
 - Includes ponds
 - Well away from the busy Church Road
- 17) Allotments
 - All located together to foster a community allotment spirit
 - Fenced to prevent unwanted entry of people, dogs and rabbits
 - Car parking nearby
 - Quality growing imported soil provided
 - 2no water troughs relocated
- 18) Ponds
 - Located at the lowest point of the site to collect and control water run off.
 - Overflow into the existing ditch adjacent.
