Anti-social behaviour in and around the Mud Cycle Track

Some users of the Track have climbed the fence behind the Track to access the adjacent Market Garden area in order to use the tenant's water tap and hose pipe. In doing so, they trampled on and ruined some of the tenant's crops, on which he relies for his livelihood.

We would like to make it clear that the Market Garden area, and indeed the Allotments, are private property and access is permitted only to the tenant and allotment holders, respectively.

This behaviour is unacceptable and, if it is repeated, we will close the Cycle Track for a period. This will be unfortunate, especially with the school holidays approaching, as it will impact adversely on many youngsters' enjoyment of this community facility.

Vandalism on the Jubilee Field

The fixtures securing the nets to the Parish Council-owned goals on the Jubilee Field have been repeatedly and seemingly deliberately broken, despite being replaced by our Field Manager on numerous occasions. In addition, signs previously erected requesting users not to climb on the nets or swing from the goals have been removed.

If there is further damage to the goal net fixings, we will remove the nets. Once again, this would have an unfortunate impact on the many users who appreciate the facility, caused by a poor attitude of a few people.

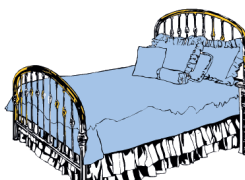

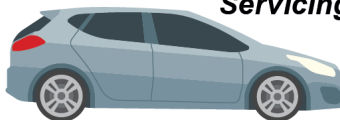

Wychavon Resilience Grants

£400,000 is available for small revenue grants to support voluntary organisations to become stronger and less reliant on local authority funding in the future. £50,000 is available to support the costs of energy audits and the implementation of energy efficiency and carbon reduction measures in community buildings, and a further £50,000 is available to support communities to improve biodiversity in their local area. The deadline for the first round of grants is 21st August but there will be two further rounds with deadlines in February and July 2027.

We Are Wychavon Support Fund

In addition to the Resilience Grants further information about the £5m Support Fund is now available. The money will be invested over the next two years and is built around four key themes of supporting wellness, supporting business, supporting families and young people and supporting sustainable communities. Details of how each scheme will work and how residents can access them are currently being finalised and will be announced through the Council's website, social media and the local press.

Fraud and Scam Bulletin Summary (July 26)

There is a rise in cold callers pretending to be the Police (from any area of the country but especially citing 'Holborn' Police station) saying you have been a victim of fraud, sounding urgent, claiming to have found a counterfeit item belonging to you or that there has been an unauthorised use of your bank account or card. They ask for details and use them to steal your money.

Ignore all requests and put the phone down.

Wait at least 10 minutes to ensure the line is clear before calling your bank or use a different phone. If you have shared any details contact the bank's fraud department by calling 159

Parish Halls, Jubilee Playing Field and Facilities REMINDERS

Outdoor sports facilities are available on the tennis courts, one of which forms a multi-use games area equipped for basketball and football. There is no booking system for the courts so turn up, take turns, play and enjoy. NB No bikes, skateboards or scooters as the surface can be damaged by these.

The Bowls Club is in charge of running and maintaining the bowling green, and anyone wishing to play can do so as long as they are a Club member and only on designated Club days. Contact Richard London (see contacts page) for details of bookings for the green.

Please ensure that while exercising your dogs on the Playing Field, you keep them on a lead when children are present and well away from the playing area. Please ensure that, both on the Field and around the Parish, all excrement is picked up and placed in one of the dog waste bins provided. This is for everyone's safety.

NB No dogs are permitted in the Playground area.

When the Hall car parks and nearby roads are busy, please park safely, leaving gaps on the road for passing places, not opposite or within 10m of a junction and preferably not on pavements.
